Drug and Alcohol Testing for School Bus and Commercial Vehicle Drivers

If so employed, the District shall adhere to federal law and regulations requiring a drug and alcohol testing program for school bus and commercial vehicle drivers. At the time of policy adoption, the Board employed no bus drivers so this section may not apply, except for those requirements imposed on the district's outside contractor for student transportation.

This program shall comply with the requirements of federal law. The Superintendent or designee shall adopt and enact regulations consistent with the federal regulations, defining the circumstances and procedures for the testing.
