PARCC Assessmen

Approximately one half of our fifth grade students have been randomly selected to participate in field testing for the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers testing. PARCC is the



new state assessment which will replace the ISAT in the Spring of 2015. The updated state assessment is fully aligned with the new IL Learning standards, formally called the Common Core Standards, which focus on measuring students ability to think critically, problem solve, and communicate clearly. The paper-pencil testing has been replaced by a computer-based assessment, and our field test will be administered in the area of English-Language Arts only.
