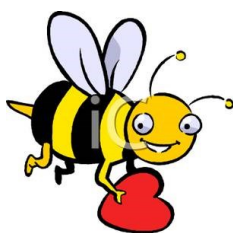
Choosing to donate is completely voluntary. The funds raised will help to save more lives each year... maybe your own... or someone that you know. Our efforts truly make a difference.

KINDERGARTEN PRE-REGISTRATION

Children who live in Peru and will be five years of age on or prior to September 1, 2015 may pre-register for kindergarten on February 25th. Registration will be held here at Northview School. Current Preschool parents that have a child that will be kindergarten age next school year will get a packet sent home with their child on Friday, February 20th. These parents can just fill out the forms and return them to the school office by February 25th. Current Northview PreK families do not have to come into the school to pre-register.



All other families, in order to pre-register your child, parents must show proof of residency (photo ID plus a current water bill or copy of a current lease or closing papers on your home). Parents must also present their child's certified birth certificate. Registration will not be allowed without the proof of residency or the certified copy of the birth certificate. All incoming kindergarten students must also show evidence of a physical examination, lead screening, dental exam, vision exam, and an updated immunization record prior to the first day of student attendance in August/September. If you know of anyone with a child ready for kindergarten, please pass on this information:
