# WINTER CONCERT REMINDERS

#### KINDERGARTEN CONCERT BEGINS AT 5:30 P.M.

• Doors will be open at 5:15 p.m. and the students will need to report directly to their classrooms at this time. <u>Students need to be making their way to the gym by 5:25</u> p.m., so any students arriving late will need to report directly to the gym. The concert will last approximately 20 minutes. Parents will then be asked to pick up their child in the classrooms after the concert and leave as soon as you can since the next group of parents will be arriving.

#### FIRST GRADE CONCERT BEGINS AT 6:15 P.M.

• The doors will already be open from the previous concert, but children do not need to be in the classrooms until 6:00 p.m. If you arrive prior to 6:00 p.m., please stay with your child in the front foyer until the hallway doors are unlocked. It is suggested you do not arrive until 6:00 p.m. By then, the kindergarten traffic should be gone and there will be more parking available since the kindergarten parents will be on their way home. Students need to be making their way to the gym by 6:10 p.m., so any students arriving late will need to report directly to the gym. This concert will also last approximately 20 minutes. Parents will then be asked to pick up their child in the classrooms after the concert.

#### SECOND GRADE CONCERT BEGINS AT 7:00 P.M.

The doors will already be open from the previous concert, but children do not need to be in the classrooms until 6:45 p.m. If you arrive prior to 6:45 p.m., please stay with your child in the front foyer until the hallway doors are unlocked. It is suggested you do not arrive until 6:40 p.m. By then, the first grade traffic should

be gone and there will be more parking available since the first grade parents will be on their way home. <u>Students need to be making their way to the gym by 6:55 p.m.</u>, so any students arriving late will need to report directly to the gym. This concert will last approximately 20-25 minutes. Parents will then be asked to pick up their child in the classrooms after the concert.

This concert will also last approximately 25 minutes. Parents will then be asked to pick up their child in the classrooms after the concert.
