

November 1, 2018 PTC Meeting Minutes

The PTC meeting was called to Order at 5:31 pm in the Northview Library.

Standing Items: Approved minutes from the October 4 meeting, Autumn Spayer, gave the treasurer's report . As of the meeting date, the PTC had a balance of \$28,900. This includes the \$872.70 that we made in School Toolboxes. Molly presented the mini grants from Northview: Aprons and Chef Hats for Kindergarten (approved by Board), Lifeskills: Snacks and cooking- \$600 for year (approved). Parkside: Medieval Times for 5th grade field trip: \$1700 (approved), Josh Dream Assembly: \$1800 (approved), Lifeskills: Cooking- \$350 for year (approved).

Under **Old Business**, Molly Leone welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for coming. Introduction of all PTC members was made.

The Fundraiser for this school year was discussed. The outcome has not be finalized as of yet, but we know that less students participated. Sort will be this Friday at 4:00 PM in the Parkside cafeteria with pick-up at Parkside from 8:00 AM- 12:00 PM.

Jen Marsala discussed the Halloween Dance. She stated that there was a lot of positive feedback from parents, students, and staff. Thank-yous to those who donated will e going out soon. An accurate count of all that attended was not made, however flow and traffic was heavy. Expenses: \$450 for DJ, with a \$50 refund due to lighting and \$495 in donations. All-in-all, \$1.29 was spent.

Next, Mary Bentley discussed the Holiday Bazaar. There were 50 vendors signed-up. So far, \$2000.00 had been made. Food for bazaar had been ordered. November 16 will be set-up and the bazaar is November 17 from 10:00AM-2:00 PM at Northview.

Under **New Business**, Volunteers were needed for Pre-K PBIS and Parkside Bookfair.
