

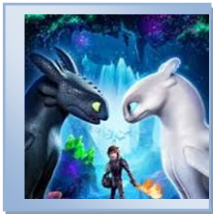

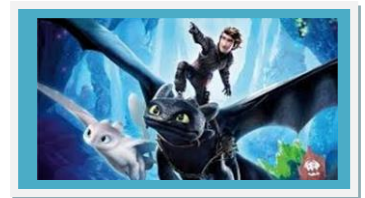
Touch a Truck

1:30pm

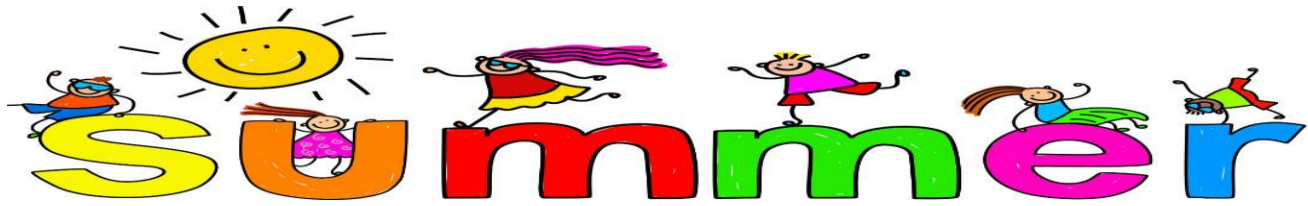
The parade will begin outside of the Peru Library and end at City Hall. Following the parade, join us at City Hall for the lighting of the tree and Christmas treats.

Swim Lessons and Swimming

The City of Peru, in conjunction with the Illinois Valley YMCA, are offering all pre-K through 4th graders, living in the City of Peru, the opportunity to participate in a Summer Swimming Program at the Illinois Valley YMCA.



Part 1. Receive unlimited swimming at the Illinois Valley YMCA, during regularly scheduled swim times. To participate, a parent or guardian will simply bring proof of Peru residency (ie. Utility bill, driver's license, etc.) and \$50 to the Illinois Valley YMCA and receive the Summer Swim Pass. The summer swim pass will valid June 1st through August 31st. Look for a flier to come home from school soon!



Part 2. The Summer Swim Pass will also include Swimming Lessons at the Illinois Valley YMCA, conducted by YMCA instructors for those students that wish to participate. There is no extra charge for the swimming lessons. Those participating in swimming lessons and completing the class will receive a certificate of completion from the YMCA. This certificate of completion can then be brought to the Peru City Clerk's office by a parent or guardian, along with proof of residency for a full refund of the original \$50 as a reward from the City for completing their swimming lessons. Look for a flier to come home from school soon.
