



IVCC STEM Academy

[Ages: 13-17] Class ID: 9563

Learn about various STEM careers and the experience and education needed to fulfill your career goals. This interactive, 3-day, career exploration camp, led by IVCC faculty, will focus on occupations in electronics, computer aided drafting and industrial technology.

Tuesday | Computer Aided Design

Students should bring their imagination and big ideas to this session where they will learn to model their designs in three dimensions and print them on a 3D printer.

Wednesday | Electronics

Students will learn to read schematics essential to assemble and solder a "mystery electronic project," that will provide for hours of entertainment after class! Students will identify key electronic components on a schematic, operate a soldering iron and troubleshoot their project to perfection!

Thursday | Industrial Technology

Build real-life hydraulic and pneumatic circuits while working together as a team to accomplish goals. The camp will conclude by making air-powered rockets of varying sizes, and from multiple materials, to see whose will fly the farthest using a launcher they build.



Jr. Welding Academy

Explore career opportunities and requirements to be a professional welder and metal fabricator. Students will study basic MIG welding, workplace safety, manufacturing Processes, basic print reading, and metal cutting skills to design projects to specification. 
