



All Illinois students in grades 3-8 take the IAR assessment each year. High school students take the SAT in English Language Arts and Math.







### **Success by Student Group**



Northview School just added to it's original building in the fall of 2015. The building more than doubled in size when a 40,000 square foot addition was completed. The existing building was totally modernized and renovated and is climate controlled. This \$12 million construction and renovation project was almost entirely funded with a state grant.
