Drug and Alcohol Testing for School Bus and Commercial Vehicle Drivers

If so employed, the District shall adhere to State and federal law and regulations requiring a drug and alcohol testing program for school bus and commercial vehicle drivers. The Superintendent or designee manage a program to implement federal and State law defining the circumstances and procedures for the testing.
