There are SO MANY ways to get help if you want it!

1. **Ask Your Teacher!!**..... in Class, Daily Study Hall, Before or After School (*please come to the office before school and we will check teacher availability*)
2. ****NEW** Morning Study Lab** – meets Tuesday-Friday mornings from **7:45-8:15am** in the computer lab. Use this time to print, complete assignments, or study for tests in a quiet environment.

Student Cell Phone Use



Students are permitted to use cell phones before and after school to listen to music or play appropriate games. Once they enter the building, phones must be turned off and stored in a locker.
