# PTC Meeting ~ March 12, 2024

#### Call to Order

### **Standing Items:**

- Secretary's Minutes discussed (Amy Eitutis) = **approved**
- Treasurer's Report discussed(Hailey Shan) = **approved**

Total combined accounts balance is \$31,255.45. Several items being paid in the near future with field trips, Fun Run, 8th grade graduation dance, Parkside end of year picnic, etc. Those totals currently stand at \$12,688.06. This leaves PTC with roughly \$18,567.39

• Review of previously approved Mini Grant to which the board voted via text on 03/04/2024 @ 4:16 pm to approve a mini grant for Northview's Reading Night in the amount of \$710.99 for Amazon and Kohl's. Sara McDonald explains what the money is being spent on and details of the Northview Reading Night.

- Mini grant was approved- submitted by Mrs. Criss in the amount of \$100.00 (to be used as a donation) for the kindergarten classes to attend the Little Mermaid production at St. Bede Academy. There is no fee to attend the event.
- Mini grant was approved- submitted by Mrs. Heiberger for \$135.00. This was for Classroomscreen. A new tool that all five of the 2nd grade classrooms will try using for organizational help.

#### **New Business:**

• The Bingo Night expenses/monies earned are reviewed by Carolyn Freed. A total of 399 tickets out of 400 were sold. After expenses of \$1565.18 a total of \$1861.99 was profited for the event. The Board agrees the event went smoothly. There was a discussion held about the placement of the prize table and raffle items table. The Board agrees it may be best to have them in separate locations to avoid confusion in the future.

- Ties and Tiaras Ball planning committee sign-up sheet is passed around amongst the attendees. The details of costs, what is included and when the flyer should go out are discussed. Tickets are passed around and the flyer for the event is discussed. Autumn Spayer states there are a lot of decorations for the event (it was done in the past) but they may need to be touched up. DJ & photographer are already booked.
- The open Board positions are discussed. Donna Alesky has been nominated for the Fundraising Coordinator position and Nicole Longbein has been nominated for the Secretary position. The Board voted and the motion was approved to fill both of those roles.
- Administrative Professionals week is 04/22/2024-04/26/2024 and the group discusses possible options for them regarding a gift/lunch, etc...
- Teacher's Appreciation week is 05/06/2024-05/10/2024 and the group discusses possible options for them. A total count of 135 staff members is given. Gift cards for Amazon are agreed upon for all Peru Elementary staff. Suggestions are made about where to provide lunch from (Stone Jug, Tony's Butt Shack, Haze Smokehouse) PTC will provide lunch for both buildings on Wed. May 8th 2024.
- National Nurses week is 05/06/2024-05/10/2024 and the group discusses possible options for them regarding a gift/lunch, etc ....
- A discussion is held about field trip chaperones. Amy Glover will put out a list of people that have participated in 3 or more PTC sponsored events and or meetings to qualify as a "2023-2024 school year PTC member". Teachers will pick chaperones needed from this list per Mr Ziegler & Mrs McDonald.

• The "Get Moving Fund Club" fundraiser is scheduled for the second week in August of the 2024-2025 school year.
