PTC meeting was called to order at 5:30pm in the Parkside Choral Room.

Standing Items: Autumn Spayer, treasurer gave the treasurer's report. To date (Sept 5, 2019), the PTC had a balance of \$24,832.94. Michelle presented mini grants from Northview; received Jul 17; K-4 Autism Life Skills: Snacks and cooking activities for the school year...\$600 (approved by Board). Received Sept 5; Preschool: Field trip to Boggios...\$440 (approved). Mini grant requests for Parkside; received Aug 5; 5-8 Life Skills Program: Snacks and cooking activities for the school year...\$600 (approved by Board).

School Toolbox was successfully completed. The 6-8th grade boxes were late, but were finally delivered to all students that ordered them. A calculator was purchased by PTC to replace a calculator that was missing from one student's box.

New Business: Michelle welcomed and thanked all in attendance. Everyone introduced themselves and the role they play within the PTC.

Michelle stated that Back to School Teacher Gifts were given. This year the PTC gave a Magic Eraser for their classroom. She spoke about parent involvement and some upcoming volunteer opportunities, letting all know that even the smallest amount of time would be helpful and appreciated. Information about ways to get involved can be found on the PTC tab of the district website.

Autumn talked about Box Tops. Since last year it has become a PTC thing, instead of having the school handle it. They are going digital instead of cutting and pasting to submit. This brings in anywhere from \$700-\$1000. Ways were discussed to get more people to participate in it. Someone had mentioned a "classroom contest" for number submitted.

Michelle discussed the Fall Fundraiser--totally different, with no product to sell. Kick-off is scheduled for Sept 17. Kids will come home with an online link and a pledge sheet for cash or check donations. Our goal for this year is \$60 per student. There are incentives for students that earn more than \$60. Golden Ticket Prize Days are on Sept 18 and 19. Day of Awesomeness will be Oct. 24 and will be at Northview.

Halloween Dance will be Oct 25 from 5:30-7:30 for Northview students and their families. Jen Marsala will head the planning committee and needs volunteers to assist.

Holiday Bazaar will be Nov 16. Mary is working on the planning. Set-up will be Nov. 15 at Northview, and volunteers will be needed.
