Learn CPR, splinting and vital sign assessment, followed by a hands-on ambulance simulation. Students will gain insight into the importance of reliability in EMS professions.

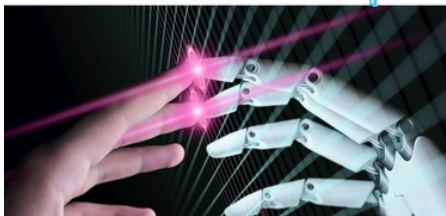
### THURSDAY | OSF HOSPITAL TOUR & CAREER EXPLORATION

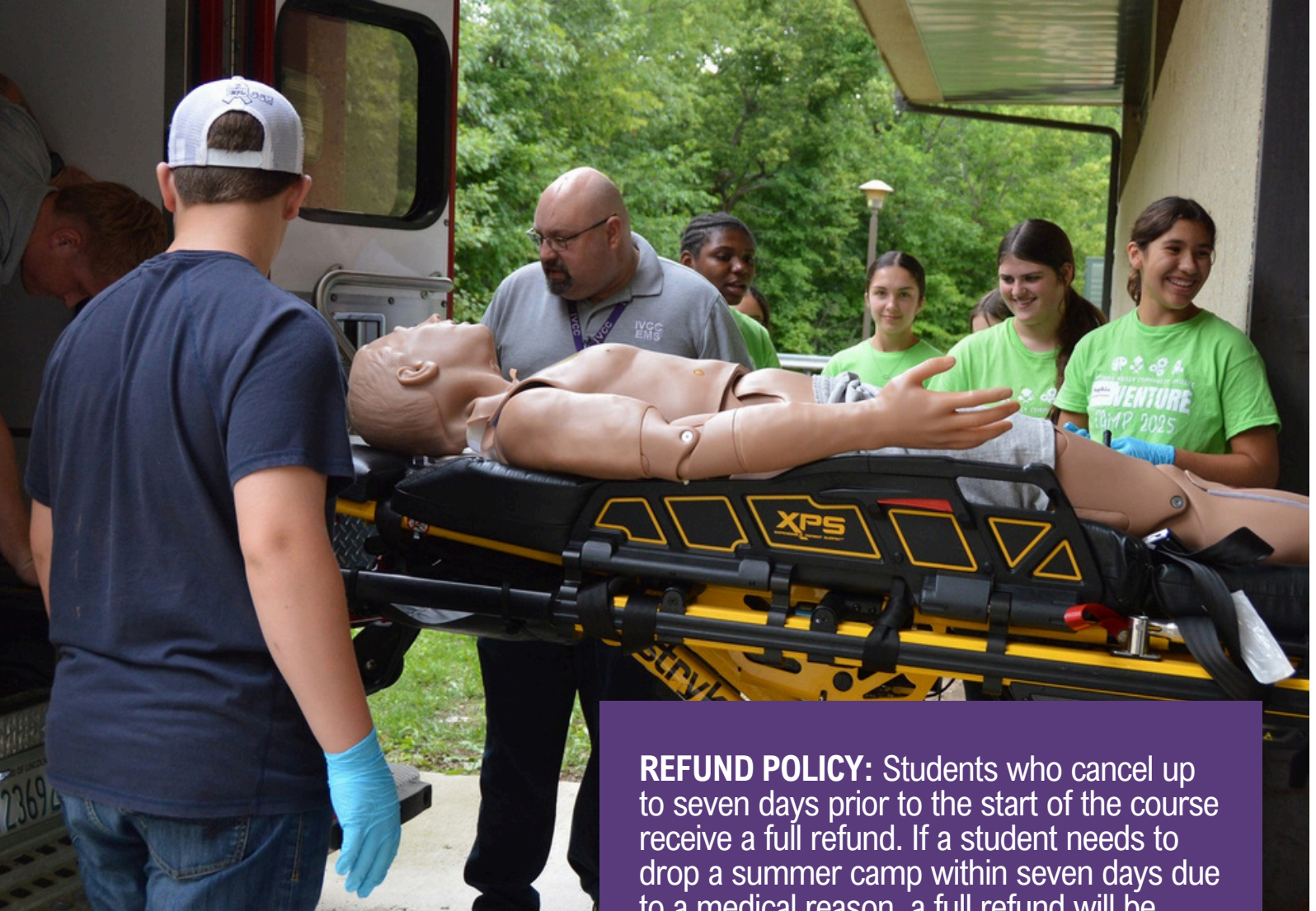
