Open Gym Parent Permission Form

The Illinois Elementary School Association (IESA) is allowing member schools to have open gyms for those sports identified in the medium-risk category. This category includes Boys and Girls Basketball and Volleyball.

IESA parameters include that:

- Teams in medium-risk sports can have intra-squad scrimmages with their own players if parents give consent for their children to participate in these scrimmages.
- Schools develop their own local consent forms.
- Students must wear face coverings during intra-squad scrimmages in medium-risk sports when indoors. When students and coaches are social distancing outdoors, face coverings do not need to be worn.
- Schools are not allowed to scrimmage or have contests with other schools in any sports during this contact period.

Peru Elementary School District 124 administration or staff cannot guarantee that students will be social distancing at all times during activities such as basketball and volleyball. Open Gyms will be structured to minimize close contact as much as possible but such athletic activities naturally lend themselves to periodic close contact.
