Options for Covid Testing (Rapid Antigen and Molecular PCR tests)

Please contact your Healthcare Provider first to discuss symptoms and treatment, as they know your child's health history the best.

- 1) Walgreens' website **www.walgreens.com/covid19testing** lets you schedule online free, rapid diagnostic tests (ID NOW) at the Peru or Ottawa location, results come back online and in less than 24 hrs. No charge.
- 2) LaSalle County Health Department now schedules ALL COVID-19 tests online. Walk-ins are not accepted. Testing is available by appointment on Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9 am until noon. They offer Rapid Antigen test, Send out PCR, and Abbott IDNOW Rapid Molecular/NAAT test all at no charge. Go to www.lasallecountyil.gov and click on the COVID-19 Resource page to schedule.
- 3) St. Margaret's Mobile Testing Unit offers free, rapid antigen tests 7 days a week * But there is a \$25 registration fee that is billed to insurance. Drive up 8:30 am-5 pm, non holiday weekdays and 8 am-11 pm weekends and holidays. Need photo ID and insurance card. Results given in 15 minutes.
- Hyvee in Peru offers both rapid antigen tests (results within a few hours) and PCR tests (results back in 1-3 days). Both tests can be scheduled online at <u>www.hy-vee.com/my-pharmacy/services/covid-19-testing</u>
- 5) CVS pharmacies in Ottawa and Mendota (not Peru location at this time) offers drive through PCR testing. No charge. To schedule go to <u>COVID-19 Testing and Locations |</u> <u>MinuteClinic (cvs.com)</u> Results back in 1-2 days.
- 6) OSF UrgoCare in Ottawa offers appointments with a provider, when you cannot see your regular family physician/provider. Appts can be booked at <u>www.osfhealthcare.org</u> or call 815-431-3410. A provider will see your student and consider rapid antigen testing. Note these tests are then sent to OSF Peoria lab to verify a PCR. Those results are received in 1-2 days and it is billed to your insurance.
